Plant Sale Conditions

- Only financial members of an Orchid Society, who have submitted one plant for judging, will be eligible to lodge an unlimited number of plants, as per schedule, for sale.
- Unnamed orchid plants will not be accepted for sale unless they are in flower.
- Plants must be clean, virus free and well established. The plant sales co-ordinator shall have the right to refuse any plant which does not meet a satisfactory standard.
- Plants need to be lodged by 7.30 pm on the Friday Evening.
- No plants, once lodged, are to be removed without the prior approval of the plant sales co-ordinator or representative.
- All reasonable care will be taken of the plants lodged for sale, but the basis of such acceptance will be that the Society and its members will not be liable for any loss or damage sustained thereto.
- Plants on sales benches will be proportioned equally between the nurseries, members, and non-members of the Society, as far as practicable, being under the total control of the plant sales co-ordinator.
- At the time of lodgement of plants for sale a signed **Plant Lodgement Form** is to be completed and handed to the plant sales co-ordinator.
- Approved Aspley Orchid Society plant labels must be used and securely attached to the plants. Labels must be fully completed and identified by your society number
- Plants to be priced using whole dollars only.
- A commission of 15% will be deducted by the Society. Proceeds from the sale of plants will be paid as soon as practicable after the show.
- Plants not sold to be collected at (**3pm at the February show; 4pm at the May show**) to enable exhibitors etc. to be back in the hall for the presentations.
- **Fire ant regulations, as they exist at the time of the show, must be adhered to.**
